2022 DIABETES RESEARCH GRANTS UP FOR GRABS

WA's peak diabetes research funding group is urging the state's medical researchers to apply for grants it is offering for 2022 projects.

Diabetes Research WA is again putting two \$60,000 research grants up for grabs to help keep WA researchers in the lab looking for breakthrough discoveries.

The winners of the grants will be announced around World Diabetes Day, held on November 14 each year.

Diabetes Research WA executive director Sherl Westlund said: "This year the world is celebrating 100 years since the discovery of insulin – a breakthrough which has saved the lives of so many people – but we still need to make new advances in tackling all forms of diabetes which are impacting more and more families globally."

Ms Westlund praised the charity's donors, both corporate and individual, saying the grants were only possible with the support of the community.
