NEW WA RESEARCH REVEALED ON WORLD DIABETES DAY

Western Australia's peak diabetes research funding group will unveil its newly-funded research projects at a free event on World Diabetes Day in Crawley.

Diabetes Research WA's *Research Reveal Breakfast* kicks off at 7.15am on Thursday November 14.

The event will showcase the charity's two winning research projects for 2020, each of which are being funded with \$60,000 research grants made possible thanks to community donations.

As well, Dr Aveni Haynes from the Telethon Kids Institute will speak about the progress of her Diabetes Research WA-funded world first project using continuous glucose monitoring technology to study the blood sugar patterns of children at risk of type 1 diabetes to inform future prevention strategies aimed at reversing, delaying or preventing the development of the condition.

And fellow 2019 grant winner Professor Kevin Pflieger from the Perkins Institute will discuss his latest research into a molecule called RAGE, which could be used as a target to limit the complications of type 2 diabetes developing.
